

## Form T2201 Effects of impairment

"Severely impaired mental functioning resulting in significant thinking and concentration problems accompanied by prominent distress and dysphoria" (taken from psychology assessment)  
Disturbed thinking patterns associated with psychotic episodes. Marked by confusion, distractibility, and difficulty concentrating.  
Persistent features of severe depression and anxiety, despite treatment. Suspiciousness and hostility impair social interactions.  
He requires assistance and reminders for most of his ADL's due to his mental functioning.

Severely impaired mental functioning resulting in significant thinking and concentration problems accompanied by permanent distress and dysphoria. Disturbed thinking patterns associated with psychotic disorder. Marked by confusion, distractibility and difficulty concentrating. Persistent features of severe depression and anxiety despite treatment. Suspiciousness and hostility impact social interactions. He requires assistance and reminders for most of his activities of daily living.
